Dear Fellow Hawaiian Flight Attendant:

We have heard two questions about the passage of the 10-hour required rest period for Flight Attendants: 1. When will the rest period be implemented and 2. How will it affect the Hawaiian Flight Attendants?

We have been told by the AFA International office that the timeline has not been set up. The FAA Reauthorization bill must first be signed by President Trump and then goes to the Department of Transportation (DOT) for the implementation schedule. In 1994 when the first Flight Attendant FARs were passed DOT gave the airlines 6 months to implement the new FARs. We will let you know as soon as we are notified.

We can also say that at this time we do not have any specifics as to how this will affect the pairings and we do not want to speculate. The Company will be working on their options as soon as they get all the specifics from the Department of Transportation.

We will let you know as soon as we know more.
