FlightPAC

We saw a significant drop in our FlightPAC contributions after the retirement, and LOA of so many of our flight attendant family which is true also with our AFA counterparts. As of this writing and I want to thank those that contribute, Council 43 has 32 active contributors totaling \$153.00 monthly and Council 47 has 33 contributors totaling \$233.00 monthly.

What you need to know about FlightPAC:

FlightPAC is the best way to make your voices heard in Washington. It's the most important tool that AFA has to help elect Senators and Representatives who understand and defend the issues that are important to us as Flight Attendants. FlightPAC is essential to supporting political programs which complement our legislative agenda and was established in 1982. **Membership dues are never** contributed to FlightPAC, and follow all campaign finance laws. FlightPAC contributions are voluntary. FlightPAC is non-partisan or as we like to say, "FLIGHT PARTISAN!" In these difficult and uncertain times it's more important than ever that we have a strong and powerful voice in Washington.

- **PAYROLL SUPPORT PROGRAM** or PSP: We worked hard to receive bipartisan support, keeping us connected to our careers and healthcare through the pandemic which is still an active pandemic.
- **Federal mandate for mask on planes**
