The settlement the above referenced grievance is pursuant to our agreement as part of the Hawaiian Airlines Mid-term Restructuring Agreement with the Association of Flight Attendants in April of 2003

**Issue:** the company violated Section 7.D.2.c. (1) and Section 7.C.2.c of the collective bargaining agreement by not allowing crews 18 hours of rest prior to rescheduled flight assignments.

**Settlement:** The Company will administer the agreement by applying the diurnal rest parameters to trips that have been rescheduled in such a way that they qualify as diurnal trips.
